SURGICAL APPOINTMENT at Rickmansworth Surgery

Please remember:

- Do not feed your pet after 12a.m. (Midnight) the night before their procedure.
 No breakfast on the morning of the operation.
 Water can be left down over night, but taken up first thing in the morning.
- 2. Cats should be kept in overnight and provided with a litter tray.
- 3. Please bath/wash your dog the night before surgery if possible and give a short lead walk before admittance to the surgery in the morning.
- 4. If there has been any change in condition or symptoms since the surgical appointment was made please tell the admitting nurse.
- 5. Please be prepared that the admission appointment may take some time, as the nurse will need to go through a consent form with you. Punctuality in the morning helps us to get your pet home with you as soon as possible.
- 6. Please be aware that you will be expected to pay in full when you collect your animal. Written estimates are available on request.
- 7. A buster collar will be automatically provided unless you have one at home And bring it with you on the morning of the operation.
- 8. You will also be asked by the Nurse if you wish your pet to be Identichipped while under anaesthetic (with 10% discount) and your pet will then be registered for life. For any pet over 8 years old you will be routinely offered a preanaesthetic blood test. Please ask the nurse for more information and charges.
- 9. Due to lungworm in the area, dogs having surgery should be dosed with Advocate to minimise bleeding risk. Please apply(date)
